Northern Territory Disaster Impact Survey

Self-assessment Guide

<u>The Northern Territory Disaster Impact Survey</u> allows you to do a self-assessment of your property after a disaster event has occurred. This instruction sheet should guide you through the process of filling in and submitting the survey.

To complete the survey click on the survey link above and go through each question. The survey can be completed on a smart phone, tablet, computer or other standard device.

Some questions must be completed in order to submit the survey. While other questions are optional, the details provided helps us to better understand the level of impact of the disaster event to your property. Once you are done hit the **Submit** button to submit your self-assessment survey.

If you are unsure of the level of impact, an estimate will be adequate for the purposes of this survey. If there are additional impacts to your property that haven't been captured, please include them in the free text field at the end of the survey.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

I received this survey but my property was not damaged by a recent disaster event?

Please fill in your property location information and select 'No' to the question, then submit the survey. This will help us gain an understanding of the extent of the disaster event.

What date should I use if the disaster event occurred for several days?

Please use the approximate **start date** of the event.

Are there guidelines for rating the impact to my property?

No, the purpose of this question is to provide a rating based on how you think normal production on your property has been impacted. If you want to provide further information on why you chose a particular level of impact, please use the text box at the end of the survey.

I can't find my address or property name using the search function?

If you cannot find your address or property name, please drop a pin on the map within the boundaries of your property's location.

I am not sure of my PIC (Property Identification Code)?

You can use the Northern Territory PIC search to find your PIC.

My property has multiple PICs, how do I enter them?

You can add all PICs relevant to your property by adding a comma (,) between each identifier.

Why do I need to provide insurance information?

As <u>the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements</u> require insurance information for assessment, this question provides an estimate on insurance payouts for the disaster event.



How do I account for livestock affected due to lost pastures or feed?

The 'Total number of stock affected by this event' question includes stock that were affected but are not dead, injured or missing. If your stock have been affected for reasons not listed in the survey, please provide additional information in the text box at the end of the survey.
