

DECLARATION OF A FIRE DANGER AREA AND FIRE DANGER PERIOD

The Executive Director of Bushfires NT, Department of Environment and Natural Resources, hereby gives notice that, under section 62(a) of the *Bushfires Management Act* and with reference to section 63 of the Act, declare the period from **2 July 2018 to 31 December 2018** to be a fire danger period in the part of the Territory that lies north of the 19th parallel of South latitude (approximately 70kms north of Tennant Creek).

The major effect of this declaration is that, throughout the declared area, a permit to burn is required before any burning is conducted, and a person must not leave an area before thoroughly extinguishing any fire they have lit. There are substantial penalties for failing to comply with these requirements.
